Environmental Policy

Purpose and Statement

Titan International (Titan) is dedicated to the continual improvement of environmental performance of our global operations and to reducing or eliminating wherever practical any adverse environmental impacts through proper energy management, waste reduction, recycling/reuse, pollution prevention, and emissions control. Titan is committed to protecting the environment where feasible and responsibly using natural resources through efficient use of water, energy, and raw materials. This policy applies to all Titan operations globally, including subsidiaries and joint ventures, and to all Titan suppliers and contractors. This policy has been approved by Titan's senior management and the Board of Directors and is aligned with other Titan policies.

Titan acknowledges its impact on the environment and commits to go further than the regulatory compliance requirements to address that impact. That is why we are working to quantify the environmental footprint that we have in our operations and putting in place environmental programs.

This will be achieved by:

- Waste minimization through source reduction, reuse, and recycling
- Maintaining the lowest possible hazardous waste generator status designations by limiting the use of potentially hazardous substances and promoting non-hazardous alternatives
- Limiting emissions of greenhouse gases and other air pollutants by implementing innovative technical and engineering solutions as well as promoting minimal to zero air emission pollutant chemicals
- Conducting routine internal environmental assessment audits at our facilities as a basis to implement, upgrade, or benchmark current practices and performance to meet our goals

To realize these commitments, the company counts on every employee to do their part in making Titan an environmental leader in the industry.

Suppliers

Titan seeks to work with suppliers that uphold these same commitments. The company does this by ensuring that materials and other substances restricted by applicable laws are not used in our production process through vendor certifications, Globally Harmonized System (GHS) compliant Safety Data Sheet review processes, and conducting chemical analysis if necessary. We require our suppliers to meet and uphold our Supplier Code of Conduct values.
