This year the race will include a corporate competition where the top corporate team will receive an award. For the one-mile event, Sensata will present awards to the top three male and female adults (18 and older) and the top three males and females in divisions for ages: 8 and younger, 9 and 10, 11 and 12, 13 and 14, and 15 through 17.
