Carlyle's largest application includes both fiber optic and copper cable assemblies for in-flight entertainment systems (IFE) on commercial aircraft, including Boeing, Airbus and the regional jet industry. Spending on IFE systems is expected to grow dramatically through 2010 fueled by new aircraft builds and retrofit applications. We are well positioned to capitalize on this opportunity." Mr. Roberts concluded, "The addition of Carlyle strategically positions us to be the leader in aerospace specialty interconnect systems."
