

Registered Shareholders and Proxyholder Appointments

The following instructions are applicable to registered shareholders (whose CTC shares are registered in their name).

Proxyholder Appointments

As in-person attendance at the Meeting will not be possible, shareholders should not appoint a proxyholder, other than the proxyholders named in the proxy form (the "Management Proxyholders"), to participate and vote on their behalf at the Meeting.

If you have already appointed a non-Management Proxyholder, please follow the instructions below.

Previously Appointed Non-Management Proxyholders

As in-person attendance at the Meeting will not be possible, we recommend that previous appointments of non-Management Proxyholders be revoked. In order to do so, go to www.investorvote.com, have your Control Number on your proxy form ready and revote; this will rescind your previous proxyholder appointment. If you submit your vote and appoint the Management Proxyholders (the default option), they are obligated to vote in accordance with your voting instructions.

If you have appointed a non-Management Proxyholder and do not wish to revoke that appointment, you must provide your Control Number on your proxy form to your appointed proxyholder and direct them to vote online at www.investorvote.com or by telephone by calling 1-866-732-VOTE (8683) Toll Free in order for your vote to be counted. Your proxyholder may vote up to and during the Meeting.

Please ensure that you provide your proxyholder with your instructions on how to vote, unless you wish to let your proxyholder decide how to vote your shares. Your proxyholder should not change the default proxyholder appointment (the Management Proxyholders) and appoint himself/herself. If the Management Proxyholders are not selected, your votes will not be reflected in the final tally.

You and your proxyholder may listen to the Meeting by joining the teleconference or logging in as a "Registered Shareholder" on the Online Platform as detailed on the www.ctcagm2020.com website.

Please note you are responsible for maintaining the confidentiality of your Control Number. Should you provide your Control Number to your proxyholder or others, you are responsible for any subsequent voting of, or subsequent inability to vote, your shares.
