FUNAMBULA is derived from the Latin term funambulus, meaning rope dancer. Produced exclusively for MGM Resorts International's Beau Rivage by Dreamcast Entertainment, FUNAMUBLA features Bello Nock and an international cast of accomplished aerialists, acrobats, contortionists, tightrope walkers, jugglers, trampoline jumpers, trapeze artists and a world champion rhythmic gymnast.

"Circus artists provoke wonder and emotion and defy words and descriptions," said DreamCast Entertainment's Misha Matorin, the show's creator and producer. "FUNAMBULA features the amazing comedic daredevil Bello Nock whose stunts, humor and charisma have won him numerous awards and the admiration of thousands of fans worldwide.
