MGM MIRAGE (NYSE: MGG) today announced that the meeting date for the 2001 Annual Meeting of Shareholders is scheduled for May 1, 2001, with a record date of March 9, 2001. The time and location of the meeting will be announced in the proxy materials, which the Company anticipates will be mailed to shareholders on or about April 6, 2001.

Its U.S. holdings include: the MGM Grand Hotel and Casino - The City of Entertainment, Bellagio, The Mirage, Treasure Island, New York - New York Hotel and Casino, the Boardwalk Hotel and Casino and 50% of Monte Carlo, all located on the Las Vegas Strip; the Golden Nugget in Downtown Las Vegas; Whiskey Pete's, Buffalo Bill's and the Primm Valley Resort in Primm, Nevada as well as two championship golf courses at the California/Nevada Stateline; the Golden Nugget in Laughlin, Nevada; the Beau Rivage resort on the Mississippi Gulf Coast; and the MGM Grand Detroit Casino in Detroit, Michigan. The Company is a joint venture partner on a resort under development in Atlantic City, New Jersey and also controls several development sites in the ocean-front resort community. Internationally, MGM MIRAGE owns and operates the MGM Grand Hotel and Casino in Darwin, Australia and manages casinos in Nelspruit, Witbank and Johannesburg, Republic of South Africa.
