

Freeport-McMoRan Copper & Gold Inc. Declares Quarterly Cash Dividends on Preferred Stocks

PHOENIX, AZ, June 25, 2009 – Freeport-McMoRan Copper & Gold Inc. (NYSE: FCX) today declares the following quarterly cash dividends payable on August 1, 2009 to holders of record as of July 15, 2009:

- \$1.6875 per share of FCX's 6¾% Mandatory Convertible Preferred Stock (NYSE: FCXprM).
- \$13.75 per share of FCX's 5½% Convertible Perpetual Preferred Stock.
