Employment must be entirely voluntary.</p>	<p>Wages, Benefits and Working Hours</p> <p>Our Vendors and Growers will strive to comply with the applicable wage and hour laws and regulations, including minimum wage, legal working hours and payment for overtime as may be relevant in their operation.</p>
<p>Child Labor</p> <p>Our Vendors and Growers will not use child labor as per applicable international laws.</p>	<p>Health and Safety</p> <p>Our Vendors and Growers will provide their employees with a safe and healthy work environment in compliance with all applicable laws and regulations.</p>
<p>Human Rights and Employment Practices</p> <p>Our Vendors and Growers do not discriminate in hiring and employment practices on the grounds of race, creed, color, nationality, ethnic origin, disability or other status.</p> <p>Our Vendors and Growers treat employees with respect and do not use corporal threats or punishment, or other forms of physical coercion or harassment in their management practices.</p>	<p>Protection of the environment</p> <p>Our Vendors and Growers comply with applicable local environmental laws, regulations and standards and adopt and implement the best practices that protect the environment.</p>
<p>Ethical dealings</p> <p>We expect our Vendors and Growers to conduct their operations using the highest ethical standards.
