In July 2017, Michael Kunigonis was appointed vice president and division general manager, Corning Automotive Glass Solutions, responsible for leading Corning's Automotive Glass business, providing Corning® Gorilla® Glass and other Corning glasses for automotive window and interior applications.

Prior to his current role, Kunigonis served as business director, High Performance Displays (HPD), Corning Glass Technologies, responsible for developing, manufacturing, and selling specialty glass for high-resolution LCDs and new OLED displays.

Kunigonis joined Corning in 2000, and held several market development and engineering roles. In 2005, he relocated to Hickory, North Carolina, to join the Corning Cable System's FTTH program office as a product line manager. In 2007, he was appointed strategy development manager, responsible for facilitating and developing division strategy, business development, and external development.

In February 2011, Kunigonis relocated to Corning, New York, and was named assistant chief of staff reporting to the Chairman and CEO. He was responsible for all strategic executive customer engagements, communication of next-generation specialty glass innovations, and managing the office of the CEO.

Prior to Corning, Kunigonis served six years as an engineering officer in the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers.
