In August 2009, he assumed the role of general manager and regional director of China and India, Environmental Technologies. In July 2010, he returned to the US as program director, Environmental Technologies. In 2011, Nelson assumed the role of business director, AAA Corning® Gorilla® Glass, New Business Development responsible for the AAA (Automotive, Appliance, Architecture) Gorilla Glass program. In December 2011, Nelson was appointed division vice president, Heavy Duty Diesel responsible for leading the execution of the new HDD business strategy. In June 2013, Nelson was appointed division vice president and business director, responsible for strategy, product line management, and business performance.
