

## OVERVIEW

---

Protecting your privacy is very important to Tahoe Resources Inc. and its group of companies (collectively, "Tahoe"). This Policy explains how Tahoe collects, uses and discloses the personal information you may provide while using the [tahoeresources.com](http://tahoeresources.com) Website ("Website") which is operated by Tahoe. This Policy does not apply to the information collected, used or disclosed with respect to corporate or commercial entities or to the personal information of employees of Tahoe. This Policy does not impose any limits on our collection, use or disclosure of the information exempted under applicable privacy legislation, including business contact information and certain publicly available information.

Any personal information you provide to Tahoe through the Website will be treated with care, and subject to this Policy will not be used or disclosed in ways to which you have not consented. This Policy is governed by and construed in accordance with the laws of the Province of British Columbia and, in particular, the *Personal Information Protection Act* (British Columbia).

## WHAT IS PERSONAL INFORMATION?

---

Personal information means information about an identifiable individual, not including business contact information, i.e. information that would allow an employee to be contacted at their place of business. For example, personal information includes such things as your home address and telephone number, your date of birth, your personal e-mail address, and your credit card or other financial information.

## WHAT ARE THE PURPOSES FOR THE COLLECTION, USE AND DISCLOSURE OF YOUR PERSONAL INFORMATION?

Tahoe collects, uses and discloses your personal information only for identified purposes with your knowledge and consent. Tahoe identifies these purposes to you at the time it collects this information. Some of the purposes for which Tahoe may collect, use and disclose your personal information on this Website are

- to respond to your inquiries,
- to authenticate your identity,
- to compile statistics and to operate and improve our Website,
- to monitor your compliance with any of your agreements with Tahoe, and to administer the provision or receipt of products or services under those agreements,
- to manage or transfer our assets or liabilities, for example in the case of an acquisition, disposition or merger,
- to protect yourself, Tahoe and others from fraud and error and to safeguard our business interests,
- to collect debts owed to Tahoe,
- to comply with legal and regulatory requirements, and
- if you choose, to announce ongoing business developments.

If you choose not to provide Tahoe with your personal information for any of the above purposes, the Website will not collect any personal information about you. If you have provided Tahoe with your personal information, that personal information will not be sold (except it may be transferred on the sale of the shares or assets of Tahoe). Tahoe may share your personal information with third parties to assist Tahoe to administer activities on the Website, such as website maintenance, to our auditors or other professional advisors, or otherwise for service promotions. Tahoe may also use service providers to assist in aggregating personal information.

We may transfer your personal information across provincial or national borders to fulfil any of the above purposes (including both the necessary and the optional purposes), including to service providers located in the United States of America and other countries outside of Canada who may be subject to applicable disclosure laws in those jurisdictions, which may result in that information becoming accessible to law enforcement and national security authorities of those jurisdictions.

## HOW DOES TAHOE OBTAIN YOUR CONSENT?

---

Tahoe obtains consent to collect, use and disclose your personal information for the reasonable and necessary purposes set out above. When you provide Tahoe with your information, such as for signing up to receive emails about new business developments, you are consenting to the collection, use and disclosure of your personal information for these purposes, in accordance with the principles outlined in this Policy.

Tahoe may disclose your personal information without your consent, pursuant to the exceptions in the applicable privacy legislation, e.g. if required by law.

If you have given Tahoe consent, you may, at any time, unsubscribe or withdraw your consent by contacting Tahoe as set out below. In some cases, withdrawal of your consent may result in Tahoe being unable to provide you with a particular service through the Website. If so, Tahoe will advise you of the consequences of your withdrawal of consent at the time.

## USE OF TECHNOLOGY ON THE WEBSITE

---

The Website uses Cookie technology to make your use of the Website more convenient. A cookie is a text file which enables the Website to store information about your activities on the Website, or the length of your stay. Any personal information that is collected by the cookies will be used only on an aggregate basis, which means that Tahoe takes the identifiers off the information and use it for statistical purposes to assist Tahoe in enhancing your online experience, or to evaluate the success of promotions that Tahoe may carry on through the Website. The Website does not collect your personal or financial information from your computer, nor does it place persistent cookies on your computer. The Website will not put cookies on your hard drive. Most web browsers are set to accept cookies by default, however, you should have an option to disable cookies associated with the Website. If you choose to do so, this may affect the functionality of the Website and your ability to access certain features of the Website.

## HOW DOES TAHOE PROTECT YOUR PERSONAL INFORMATION?

The Website endeavours to use appropriate reasonable security arrangements to prevent any unauthorized access, collection, use, disclosure, copying, modification or disposal of your personal information in accordance with applicable law. Tahoe tries to exercise care in the secure transmission of your information, however, no transmission of information over the Internet is 100% secure. Tahoe cannot guarantee that information disclosed through the Internet cannot be intercepted by third parties. However, Tahoe has taken the steps that are reasonably available to Tahoe to protect any personal information that you have provided to Tahoe, including, in its disposal or destruction in due course.

Please remember that you control what personal information you provide while using the Website. Ultimately, you are responsible for maintaining the secrecy of any personal information you provide in connection with the use of the Website. Tahoe is not responsible for, and cannot control, the use by others of any information which you provide, and you should use caution in selecting the personal information you provide through the Website.
